This responds to your request for a Mandatory Declassification Review (MDR) under Executive Order 13526 for documents pertaining to the 107<sup>th</sup> Congress Joint Inquiry into the Intelligence Community Activities before and after the Terrorist Attacks of September 11, 2001, specifically pages 416 through 443: (MDR 2013-03597). The Office of Information and Privacy (OIP), Department of Justice (DOJ), referred your June 26, 2013 letter to us for appropriate action and direct response to you.

Our records show that the files pertaining to your MDR request were processed for a declassification review under Executive Order 13526 on February 2, 2014. The documents continue to warrant classification under Executive Order 13526. Your case has been assigned # 1220442 by the FBI and the documents will now undergo a Freedom of Information Review for unclassified portions that may be processed and released to you.

You may appeal any denials contained herein by writing to the Co-Director, Office of Information and Privacy, United States Department of Justice, Flag Building, Suite 570, Washington DC, 20530, within sixty (60) days from receipt of this letter.
