In response to your FOIA request, 11 additional pages were located via text searches of third party names as required pursuant to the Court's April 4, 2014 Order.

Upon review of the above information, we determined that information on one page previously released to you (SARASOTA-6) is no longer classified. This information was previously exempt under Exemption (b)(1). However, the information is still being withheld pursuant to other applicable FOIA exemptions. This page, from FOIA Number 1176403-002, is being re-released to you, along with the first page of the serial, which now contains different classification stamps.

Duplication fees are assessed at the rate of ten cents per page, with the first 100 pages being free of charge. In addition, there are no fees assessed if the search and duplication costs for the remaining pages do not exceed \$14.10. Therefore, the enclosed documents are being forwarded to you at no charge.

#### EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS




