The Broward Office of the Inspector General (OIG) received an anonymous tip alleging misconduct within Broward County Transit, to include bus operators being paid overtime in June 2018 to drive buses to Fleet Services on Blount Road in order to hide the buses from auditors from the United States Department of Transportation.

The OIG did not receive this tip directly from the source; it was referred to us via email by the United States Office of Professional Management (OPM). A complete copy of the email the OPM sent to the OIG is enclosed.
