B. Summary

<u>Department of Fire Rescue</u> requested the purchase of <u>Bleeding Control Kit Stations and IFAK's</u> and the above referenced Bid was issued on <u>May 31, 2019</u>.

The Bid comprised of (3195) suppliers and (2) SBA suppliers who were noticed of the Bid. Seventy-Six (76) suppliers viewed the bid, out of which three <u>3</u> were CBE/SBE vendor(s). Award of a Formal Bid may be made to the lowest responsive and responsible Local CBE/SBE vendor provided that the bid does not exceed the overall lowest responsive and responsible bidder by the following percentages for the bid amounts listed as follows:

Amount of Bid	Percent
Bids up to \$100,000	5%
Bids of \$100,000 to \$250,000	3%
Bids greater than \$250,000	1%

Responses were received from a total of $\underline{\text{Nine (9)}}$ vendors, of which consisted of: $\underline{\text{One (1)}}$ CBE/SBE vendors, $\underline{\text{Zero (0)}}$ partial bids and $\underline{\text{Two (2)}}$ no bids.

The lowest responsive, responsible bid response was submitted by North American Rescue, LLC for a one-time purchase in the amount of \$392,386.92 with the option to buy additional items with-in the next (2) years under the same terms and conditions, based on availability of funding and as is in the best interest of BSO.

The above referenced Bid has been reviewed by the Purchasing Division and request for approval to award to North American Rescue, LLC in the amount of \$750,000.00 to cover the one time purchase and any additional purchases within the two year term under the same terms and conditions of the contract.
