My name is Gregory Tony and I work for the City of Coral Springs Police Department. I've been an honored member of our Department for over 10 years. I'm currently assigned as a midnight Patrol Sergeant. I'm writing you as I noticed the Coral Springs Fire Academy has undergone a new transition in its history by becoming the Coral Springs Regional Institute of Public Safety (CSRIPS). The goal is to increase victim survivability rates under these violent incidents via a concentricity of efforts by law enforcement, *immediate responders*, and emergency medical services. Our focus is to train the immediate responders (surrounding citizens) using a three-tiered approach for preparation.
